

BABY SHOWER GAME SUGGESTIONS 1

NAME TAG GAME: Have name tags pre-numbered, draw numbers and the number drawn wins a small plant.

PLATE GAME: Place a baby sticker on the inside of strong, thick, paper plate, pass plates out to all guests, ask that they keep them face down. Instruct them to turn over plates, who ever has the sticker wins a price. On the same plates you can also write a number, or use number stickers, draw a number and the number drawn will win a small plant. Use the plates for writing surfaces for games.

Q-TIP GAME: Fill up a baby bottle with Q-tips, pass the bottle around to each guest. Have everyone write their guess down, closest guess wins a prize.

NAME GAME: If the baby is already named, write the baby's name down, (the meaning of the baby's name can also be added.) Have each guest make as many words as possible from the name. The person with the most words wins.

STRING GAME: For this game you'll need yarn and scissors. Pass around the scissors and yarn (pastels colors are nice), have each guest guess how long of a piece will wrap around the mom to be's waist. Measure the yarn around the mom's waist, cut and pass around to each guest to find the closest one. The closest in length wins. This is a fun keepsake for the baby book.
